Directions

From East County take Route 8 West to 805 South to Route 905 East (almost to the Mexican border). If you are coming from the Los Angeles area, come South on Route 5 or Route 15 and take the 805 South to Route 905 East. (If you are in the San Diego area and are closer to 5 South than to 805 South, take 5 South to 905 East.)

Route 905 East starts out as a freeway then turns into a divided highway with traffic lights.

Count down 11 traffic lights (as a landmark, there is a 7-Eleven at the 8th traffic light), merge into your far left lane and continue straight to the 11th traffic light, (OTAY MESA ROAD). Otay Mesa Road is a two-lane paved country road. Follow it to the end. At the stop sign you will HAVE to turn left - this is ALTA ROAD.

Follow Alta Road (DO NOT TURN OFF!), going down the canyon then up the hill. As you round the curve coming up the hill you will see a turn-off on the LEFT for the Firearms Training Center (if you miss it, you can turn around at the top of the hill). Park and come in central doors by Flagpole.
