The Ray Bullock Scholarship will be given annually by the California Chapter honoring California Chapter Members for their volunteer and Charity work as well as their excellence in their profession.

It is a great honor to give out this award in Ray Bullocks name, so that his legacy and his spirit can live on.

Applicants must be currently employed in the field of correctional food. Applicants must be members of ACFSA in good standing (dues paid) and have been a member for at least the last 12 months. The applicant must also be a member in good standing at the time of award and use of the scholarship. The ACFSA California Chapter Board will verify this.

A completed, application must be postmarked or electronically time-stamped on or before the designated date. The application must be completed in full and signed by the applicant and his/her supervisor. The supervisor's signature will be considered as both authorization and as a recommendation. Scholarships are to be used to attend ACFSA conferences. Board Members of the ACFSA are not eligible to receive scholarship awards while in office. No one directly involved in selecting recipients shall be eligible for an award. The award of scholarship funds will be selected on a non-discriminatory basis.

If the awarded scholarship is not utilized the funds will revert to the Scholarship Fund. Under these circumstances. Scholarships are to be used by the applicant only and are nontransferable.
