

SECURITY REGULATIONS

1. Individuals wearing blue shirts (including blue chambray), blue denim trousers, or other similar clothing will **not** be permitted to enter Mule Creek State Prison. Inmates wear blue chambray shirts and denim trousers.
2. Cellular telephones, pagers, laptop computers, or PDA (Personal Digital Assistants, i.e. Palm Pilots) are **not** permitted within the secure perimeter. Please leave them in your locked vehicle.
3. It is unlawful to bring alcohol, tobacco products, drugs, firearms, ammunition, and weapons, explosive, tear gas or tear gas weapons onto the property of Mule Creek State Prison. Weapons include any size pocketknife, utility tools (i.e. Leatherman Tool), box cutter, and any aerosol chemical agent (i.e. oleo capsicum.)
4. Sworn police officer are required to secure their weapons in provided receptacles in accordance with Mule Creek State Prison Policies and Procedures.
5. Individuals will be required to present their California Driver's License or other qualified photo identification to the officer at the entry control point. **Those persons without photo identification will not be permitted entry.**
6. By entering prison grounds, visitors consent to a search of their person, property, and vehicles. Visitors may be required to walk through a metal detector as search of their person.
7. Only individuals whose names have been submitted for a Gate Clearance, and who have passed the Gate Clearance procedure will be allowed entry. A sponsor will then escort individuals to the area authorized for the visit.
8. Service and repair personnel are required to bring a complete inventory of all tools brought into the institution. This inventory will be checked upon their arrival and departure.

Please observe the following guidelines while on the grounds of Mule Creek State Prison. Do not hesitate to notify your escort if there is any question about what action you should take.

- **Do not give any inmate, anything.** Example: An inmate asks you for a cigarette, matches, or a lighter.
- **Do not accept anything from an inmate.** Example: An inmate offers you an apple from his lunch or a sketch that he has drawn.
- **Do not do anything for an inmate.** Example: If an inmate asks you to mail something for him, decline and notify your escort.
